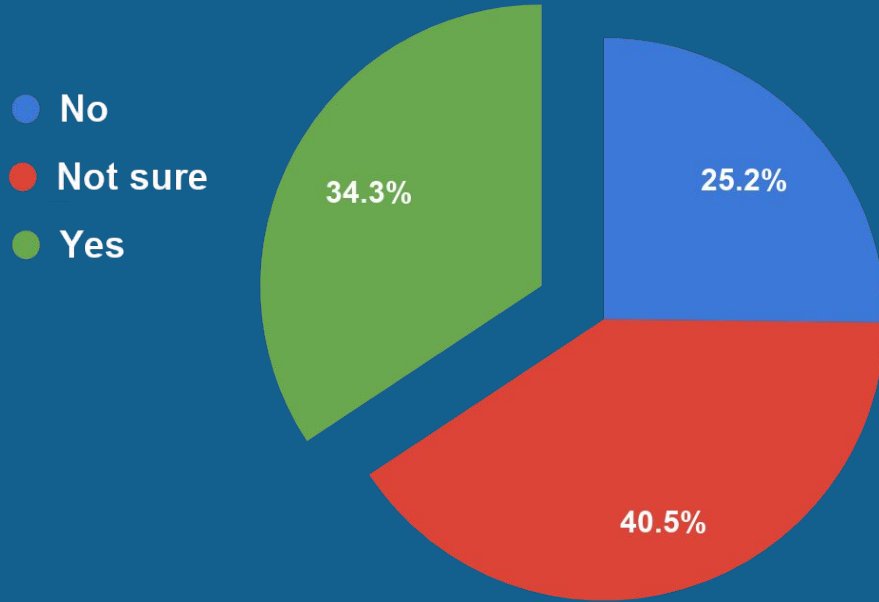
Before NYC's last minute decision to fund the Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP), grassroots leaders were already planning to engage more than

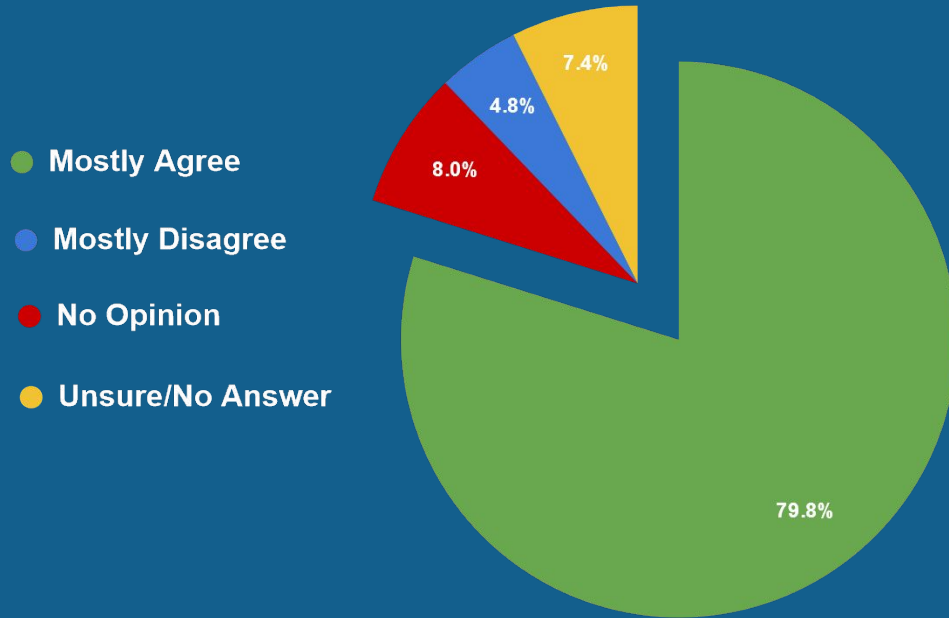
# Funding for Police-Community Relations Projects
